- Amey Pond - is in the corner of Adams County just north of Columbia County and West of Marquette Cty. Amey Pond is 56 acres of water surrounded by about 80% of State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources or...
- Arkdale Lake - is located in Strongs prairie township of Adams county it's actually a flowage of Big Roche-A-Cri Creek which also forms Big Roche-a-Cri lake to the Northeast and flows into...
- Arrowhead Lake - is also known as Manchester Lake (according to the official Wisconsin Lake Book by WI Department of Natural Resource) It's the second largest of the Tri-lakes with about...
- Big Roche-A-Cri Lake - is formed by Big Roche-A-Cri Creek in Preston Township, Adams County WI on Highway 13 in between Wisconsin Rapids and Adams & Friendship. This 200 acre ski able lake has an average...
- Big Spring Lake - also known as Big Spring Pond is located in New Haven Township of Adams County. Big Spring is about 7 acres and 5 & 7 feet deep, but...
- Camelot Lake - is the largest of the Tri-lakes with a sand bottom, about 445 acres of water, a max depth of 24 ft. and an average depth of 9 ft. Fourteen mile creek flows into...
- Castle Rock Lake - is Wisconsin's forth largest body of water (13,955 Acres), created by Wisconsin River Power Company in the 1940s by building a Hydroelectric Dam. Castle Rock Lake is also known as Castle Rock Flowage. It has plenty of fine waterfront real estate around...
- Crooked Lake - Crooked Lake is located in Jackson Township of Adams County where you can find about many other small fishing lakes similar to this one...
- Deep Lake - is about 47 feet deep and 35 acres total. It is home to Largemouth Bass, North Pike and a wide variety of panfish. About 50% of Deep Lake is divided into...
- Easton Lake - located right in the little town of Easton is located in Easton Township in Adams County, just north of Wisconsin Dells. This 24 acre lake is...
- Easton Shores Lake - is a brand new lake as far as the public is concerned due to the recent development around the lake. This small lake which is part of risk creek, flows...

- Fawn Lake - Fawn Lake is a 20 acre body of water located in Dell Prairie Township of Adams County, Central Wisconsin, just 15 minutes north of the famous Wisconsin Dells. There's not much...
- Fenners Lake - Fenner Lake, also known as Fenners Lake is located right on the county line between New Chester Township in Adams County & Westfield Township in Marquette County. The lake itself
- Friendship Lake - Friendship Lake is located in Adams County, Central Wisconsin just outside Friendship Village. The lake is formed by both Little Roche-A-Cri Creek and Fordham Creek which are controlled by...
- Goose Lake - is a well know fishing lake in Jackson Township, Adams County, WI. Here you'll find a small public beach / boat launch surrounded by older vacation homes and some...
- Hill Lake - is a small private fishing lake owned and controlled by...
- Jordan Lake - also known as Long Lake is located in Jackson Township and is one of the more popular lakes on the southern end of Adams County due...
- Mason Lake - is an 855 acre fishing lake that is shared with the Township of New Haven in Adams County and Douglas Township in Marquette County, Wisconsin. Mason Lake is...
- McCall Lake - is roughly 4.4 acres with .34 miles of shoreline and is 37 feet deep and it's on the north end of Mason Lake.
- McDougall Lake - is a smaller lake about 9 acres in size with an unknown depth but 60% of the lake frontage or better is controlled by 1 family and the remainder is developed into residential...
- McGinnis Lake - is a smaller 33 acre fishing lake with a small public access lot right off Cty Rd G on the eastside. McGinnis Lake is located in New Chester Township, Adams County just north of...
- Parker Lake - is a 50 acre lake open to skiing with its own County Park called... You guessed it, Parker Lake County Park located right on State Hwy 82 in Jackson Township...
- Partrick Lake - has it's own County Park called Patrick Lake County Park located off of Cty Rd E in New Chester Township in...
- Peppermill Lake - Peppermill Lake also known as Beaver Pond has a NEW \$4 per day (or \$10 per Season) unmanned boat launch fee via Jackson Township in Adams County, WI. Earlier this year...

- Petenwell Lake - is Wisconsin's second largest body of water (23,000+ Acres), created by Wisconsin River Power Company in the 1940s by building a Hydroelectric Dam. Lake Petenwell is also known as Petenwell flowage. It has plenty of fine waterfront real estate around...

- Roller Lake - Rollers Lake is a quiet fishing lake in New Chester Township near Marquette County in Adams County. Rollers Lake is about 27 acres in size with...

- Sherwood Lake - Adams Township is home to the City of Adams and Friendship Village where the county seat is located. These two communities are the largest...
